AGE GROUPINGS

7 & Under (Group "A")

The FHS and LHHS Girls teams, along with their coaches Doug Marion and Scott Bowland will lead all sessions for this group and will emphasize:

- Skating skills development including stride development, crossovers, pivots, starting, stopping and turning.
- Puck handling skills including passing, receiving, puck control and shooting.

8 & Over (Groups "B", "C", & "D")

There will be 3 groupings of approximately 30 players, organized by birth date from the youngest to the oldest. The coaching staff will organize their sessions to enhance:

- Skating skills development including stride development, crossovers, pivots, starting, stopping and turning.
- Puck handling skills including passing, receiving, puck control and shooting.
- Shooting techniques including shooting, accuracy, control, and velocity.
- <u>Goaltenders</u> we strive to provide one on one goaltending instruction and encourage coaches to bring goaltenders with them whenever possible.

Once we have received all the applications, players will be listed in order of birth. We will email all the applicants prior to the beginning of the school to let players and parents know what group they will be in.
